MEETING SUMMARY – February 3, 2020

Attendees: Cindy Klevens (Chair), Madhumita Chatterjee, and Wendy Waskin. Alvina Snegach recorded the minutes.

Attendance failed to meet a quorum therefore the meeting is considered informal only.

1) TASKS FROM LAST MEETING

Ms. Klevens

- Submit letter to School Board about the Lead testing in schools – *Continued*.
- Contact last daycare (Rockwood Acres on Clough Rd) to obtain their lead testing results – *Continued*. Ms. Klevens reported that she was contacted by the owner who informed that she has submitted her water samples. Ms. Klevens* will check the State Lead Database for the results in 2-3 weeks' time.
- Ask Town Manager if he wants the Committee to coordinate the application for renewal of the Large Groundwater Withdrawal permit due April 2020 and if he authorizes testing of the municipal wells for sodium and chloride. – *Continued*. Ms. Klevens emailed Mr. Stack but has not heard back yet. She will follow up to obtain a reply.

Mr. Kraybill

- Contact WhiteWater representative to obtain past chloride and conductivity monitoring results, propose further testing if authorized by the Town Manager, and inquire about the evaluation of possible Iron Sequestering for the production of wells. - *Continued*.

Mr. Hooper

- Contact NH Boy Scouts Troop 75 Master to coordinate and solicit their cooperation for advertising our next annual Private Well Testing event for June 2020. – *Continued*

Members briefly discussed the Committee website, possible dates for the next well testing event (tentatively set for June 6, 2020 together with the Boy Scout Yard sale), possible dates for the post well testing information session at Baker Free Library (tentatively set for July 15th from 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM).
